

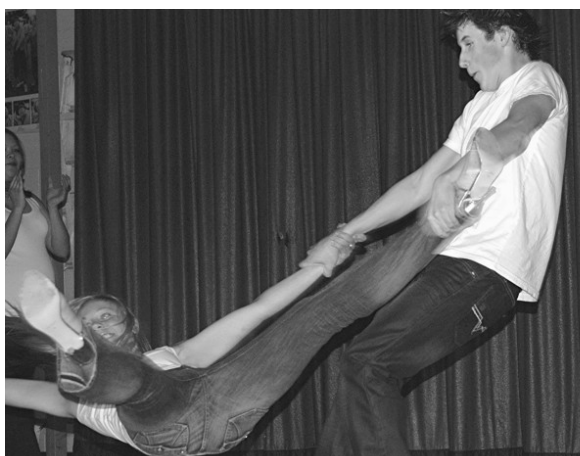
# GRAD 2K9 Dessert Theatre

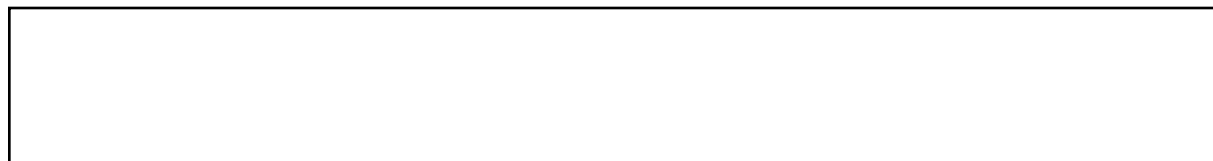

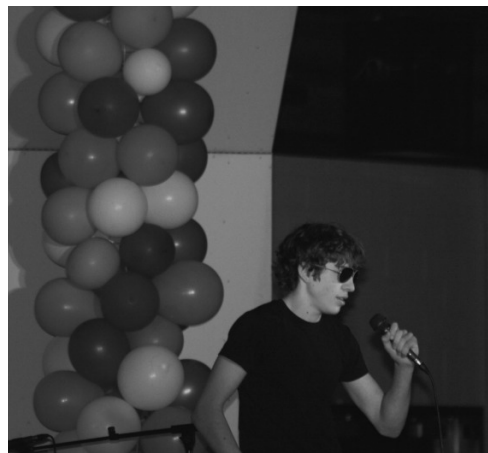
# H.S.S. IDOL
